



Code of Conduct-Student/Parent

Student-Athlete

-I will compete/prepare with a passion that never ends.

-I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, contest administrators and officials at every game.

-I will place the emotional and physical well-being of myself, teammates and opponents ahead of my personal desire to win.

-I will express my concerns through the proper channels in a dignified manner.

First Violation Penalty: Verbal warning from coach and other penalties deemed necessary by coach.

Second Violation Penalty: Meeting with coach/parents and other penalties deemed necessary by coach.

Third Violation Penalty: Meeting with coach, parents, AD and student shall lose eligibility for the next contest.

-I will accept the decisions of contest officials without arguing.

-I will not use profanity.

-I will comply with the activities dress code on days in which I compete.

First Violation Penalty: Verbal warning from coach.

Second Violation Penalty: Meeting with coach/parents/AD and possible suspension.

Third Violation Penalty: The student shall lose eligibility for the next contest.

-I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol (12) twelve months of the year.

-I will respect and obey the rules of my school and the laws of my community, state and country.

-I will respect and adhere to the MSHSL rules governing eligibility and competition.

First Violation Penalty: Student shall lose eligibility for the next two consecutive contests or two weeks, 14 calendar days, whichever is greater, of a season in which the student is a participant.

Second Violation Penalty: Student shall lose eligibility for the next six consecutive contests or three weeks, 21 calendar days, whichever is greater, in which the student is a participant.

Third Violation Penalty: Student shall lose eligibility for the next twelve consecutive contests or four weeks, 28 calendar days, whichever is greater, in which the student is a participant.

- I will stress and support the importance of the MSHSL rules.**
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstration positive support for all players, coaches, contest administrators and officials at every game.**
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes, coaches and contest officials ahead of my personal aspirations.**
- I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol (12) twelve months of the year.**
- I will remember that the game is for the students-not the adults; and will do my best to make sure that activities are fun and positive.**
- I will remain mindful that my conduct influences the respect that other athletes, coaches, parents and the public hold for the Cotter community and the athletic program.**
- I will treat other players, coaches, fans, volunteers and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, creed, ability, or affiliation.**
- I will accept the decisions of contest officials.**
- I will not undermine the coaches' instructions or directions.**
- I will not use profanity at contests.**
- I will calmly communicate my concerns through the proper channels in a dignified and adult fashion (waiting 24 hours after a contest to contact a coach. If a meeting is needed with a coach I will have my son or daughter in attendance.)**

Violation Penalty: Parent violation of the above code of conduct may result in temporary or permanent removal from any Cotter Activities Department event.
