| <p>Moral Virtues</p> | <p>Virtues gained through our efforts to accept God's gifts</p> | <p>Honesty, Respect for Persons, Compassion, Respect for Creation, Reverence for Human Life, Peacemaking</p> |

| <p>Power</p> | <p>The ability to act on freely chosen decisions affecting the world and ourselves</p> |  |

| <p>Sin</p> | <p>Being disconnected from God through a failure to love</p> |  |
| <p>Conscience</p> | <p>The inner sense of right and wrong enabling individuals to discern moral choices freely</p> |  |

| <p>Conversion</p> | <p>A change of heart with the intention of following God more faithfully</p> |  |
| <p>Grace</p> | <p>God's loving presence with us</p> |  |
| <p>Original Sin</p> | <p>Adam and Eve's refusal to treat each other and themselves as being in the image of God</p> |  |
| <p>Guilt</p> | <p>A signal to us that we are uncomfortable with our own behaviour</p> |  |
| <p>Shame</p> | <p>A message from others that we are not good or are worthless</p> |  |
| <p>Magisterium</p> | <p>The official teaching authority of the Catholic church</p> |  |
